COMMERCIAL WARRANTY

COVERAGE

Blizzard, a division of Douglas Dynamics, LLC, warrants to each purchaser of a BLIZZARD® WB walk-behind spreader that the spreader will, for a period of six (6) months after the date of original purchase, be free from defects in material and workmanship.

The foregoing warranties are exclusive and in lieu of all other express and implied warranties (except of title), including but not limited to the implied warranties or merchantability and fitness for a particular purpose.

WHAT IS NOT COVERED

This warranty shall not apply to finish or any parts not furnished by Blizzard or any damage caused by such parts, or to parts which shall have been repaired or altered by others than Blizzard so as, in Blizzard's judgment, adversely to affect the same, or which shall have been subject to other than normal use or service, negligence, accident or improper installation, maintenance, care or storage.

Blizzard will not be responsible for any expense related to parts or labor which is unrelated to defects in material and workmanship of a BLIZZARD WB spreader.

REMEDY FOR DEFECTIVE SPREADER

If within such warranty periods any part thereof is proved to Blizzard's satisfaction to be defective, such part shall be replaced by Blizzard or its authorized distributor or dealer or, at Blizzard's option, replaced FOB Blizzard's factory without charge. Blizzard's obligation hereunder shall be limited to such replacement, provided that the purchaser of that spreader has followed the procedure for obtaining warranty performance set forth below.

Blizzard's liability is expressly limited to replacement of defective parts as herein provided. Blizzard shall not be liable for any consequential, incidental or contingent damages whatsoever, whether for breach of contract, breach of warranty, negligence or other tort, or on any strict liability theory.

PROCEDURE FOR OBTAINING WARRANTY PERFORMANCE

Within ten (10) days after the discovery of any alleged defect, the purchaser of the spreader must notify Blizzard of the claimed defect, in writing, provide proof of original purchase and, at Blizzard's option, return the allegedly defective part to Blizzard FOB its factory or to its authorized distributor or dealer.
